Local Government - Reserve Assets Reporting for Elected Members

Helping to modernise the councils park and reserves reporting to Elected Members by enabling users to quickly and easily interrogate data from anywhere and on any device.

Problem.

This local council was requested by its elected members to provide easily accessible reports on the council's parks and reserves assets. The members required the reports to be simple to interpret but also have the functionality to allow a wide range of users to slice and dice the parks and reserves data as they desired.

In the past, the elected members were provided a perplexing report making it difficult for them to have a comprehensive understanding of the parks and reserves that resided within their jurisdiction. Additionally, the out-of-date static reporting afforded poor insights which meant the elected members were unable to proactively manage and effectively plan future community facilities within the council.

Solved.

At the request of the council, Exposé transitioned the council's parks and reserves asset reporting from Microsoft Excel into Microsoft Power BI. This transition converted a perplexing static report into user-friendly interactive reports which could be sliced appropriately to identify particular characteristics of interest.

The new reports present the data in a more visually appealing manner and are hosted on the web-based Power BI Service platform enabling easier access for users and greater distribution control for the council.

The reports showcase many Power BI's features allowing users to experience the benefits Power BI provides to reporting and analytics.

Business Benefits.

The work which Exposé has undertaken enables the councils elected members and other users to quickly and easily gain a broad understanding of the council's parks and reserves.
